<p>3</p>	<p>Additional organisations invited to be members of the Working Group (continued)</p> <p>Mr Gazzard confirmed he had contacted most of the organisations specified in item three of the 26 October minutes who, he confirmed were enthusiastic to assist but unfortunately were unable to attend this meeting because of other commitments. He reported he had not yet received confirmation of attendance from Truro College nor Richard Lander school and he would source a representative from the NHS.</p> <p>It was reported a representative from Newham Estate had not been contacted and Mr Lacey confirmed there was a lack of certainty regarding what is actually required from the Newham Improvement Project in terms of strategic guidance in this area. He suggested that the issues in the area be examined and consideration of mechanism such as Neighbourhood Development Orders, (where the need for planning permission for development in the area would be removed subject to conditions) to remove perceived obstacles to development and encourage more people to invest. Members considered it was important to re-engage with the Newham Project.</p>	
<p>4</p>	<p>Action Plan</p> <p>In view of many of the additional organisations invited to this meeting having been unavailable to attend, all members agreed they should be given advance notice of a meeting to be held Wednesday 11 January 2012 at 12.30 – 2.30 pm with refreshments being made available over the lunch time period. In the event of anyone being unable to attend it was considered they should be asked to send a representative from their organisation. It was also considered that members from the Steering Committee and a representative from the other Neighbourhood Plan working groups might be interested in attending this meeting.</p> <p>It was decided that, at the 30 November meeting, members of the Working Party should “thrash out” the issues seen as the way forward to be discussed at the 11 January meeting such as</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The need to look at the economy and what is a sustainable economy;• The infrastructure and links;• The future of Newquay airport;• Future of Truro Cattle Market ;• The Rural Economy; <p>In addition to include as part of our engagement workshop in December for the Steering Group a worked example of this structure of day.</p> <p>Mr Robert Lacey reported that in the Truro and Threemilestone Strategic Investment Framework (SIF) document there would be projects referenced which could change or had dropped out for various circumstances. There will also be short term, medium and long term projects within individual areas of study; for example the Newham Improvement Project is likely to contain a number of longer term projects.</p>
