1	<b>Chairman</b>  It was agreed that a Chairman for the Working Group should be appointed at the next meeting when the full membership would be able to attend.	-
2	<b>Introduction to the Neighbourhood Plan Process</b>  Mr Roger Gazzard discussed the background to the Truro and Kenwyn Neighbourhood Plan and the tasks required to be undertaken by this and the other six working groups.  He outlined that the focus for the Education Working Group was to investigate the adequacy of the current education facilities from 3 to 18 years of age and what was needed and lacking. He confirmed that statistics as to the current provision would need to be sought and evidence already collated through the production of the Core Strategy and Truro and Threemilestone Area Action Plan would be looked at.	-
3	<b>Additional organisations to be invited to be members of the Working Group</b>  Discussion took place as to what outside organisations should be invited to be members of the Working Group in which to cover education from 3 to 5 years and 16 plus, and the following organisations were agreed:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Truro College;</li><li>• Cornwall College &amp; Cornwall College Student Union;</li><li>• Combined University College, Tremough;</li><li>• Richard Lander School;</li><li>• Local Education Authority;</li><li>• Threemilestone Primary School;</li><li>• Representative of under 5's provision, e.g., Sure Start / Children's Centres.</li></ul> It was also considered that representatives of voluntary organisations, such as Scouts and Guides, should be invited to attend a meeting of the Working Group when required, as would representatives from the medical and dental schools at the Knowledge Spa, Royal Cornwall Hospital, Treリスke.	-
